- Plagiarism
- Conflict Resolution

During the workshop and lecture, participants will be engaged in discussions, group work, role play and case studies. All participants will receive relevant material: a tool-kit with institutional guidelines, local contact points, links to useful web resources as well as relevant publications, which they can refer to throughout their scientific careers.
